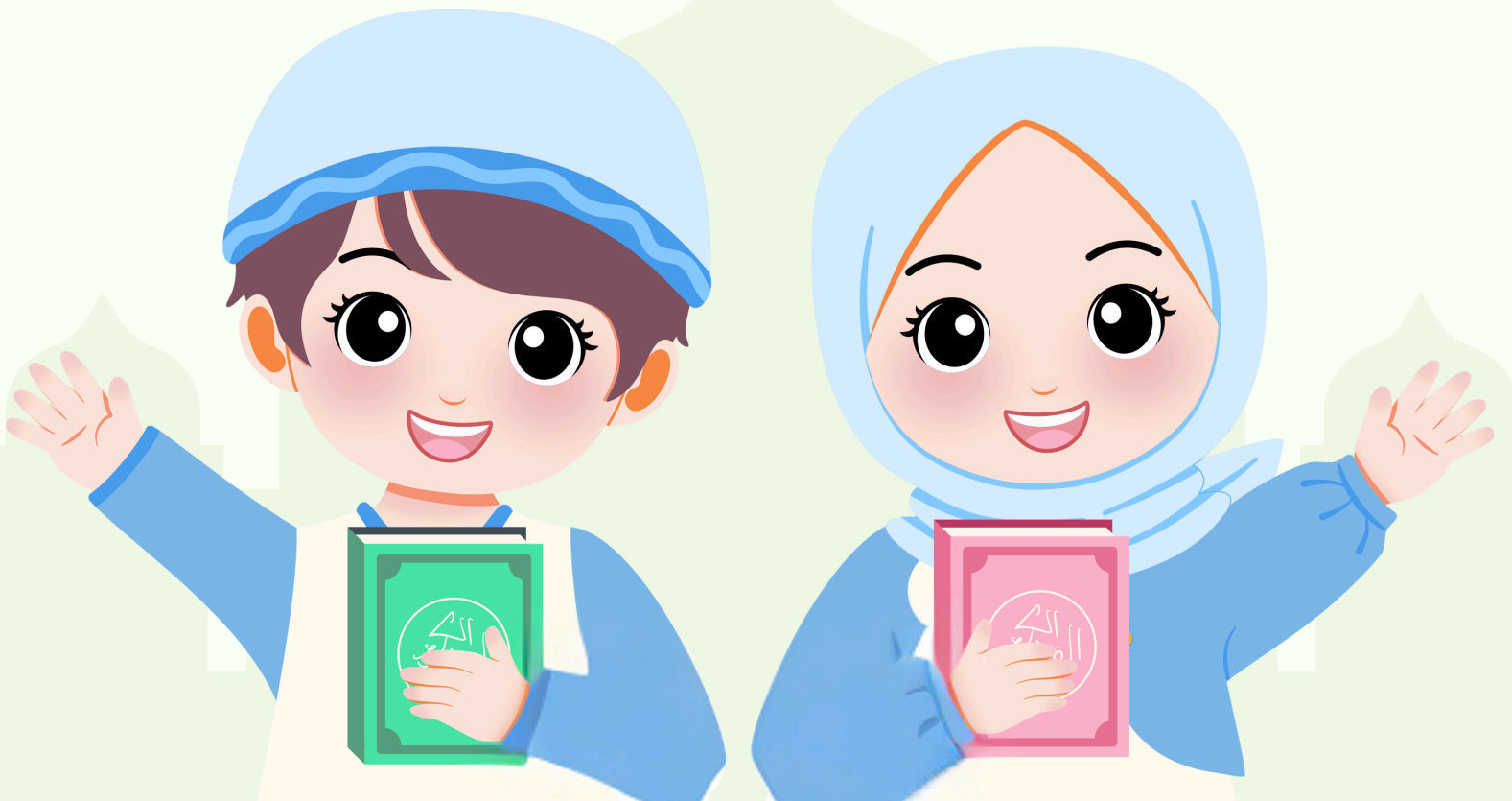

# Honored Guests of Allah

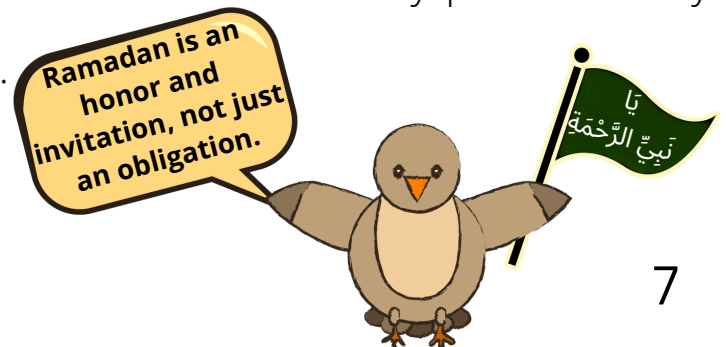

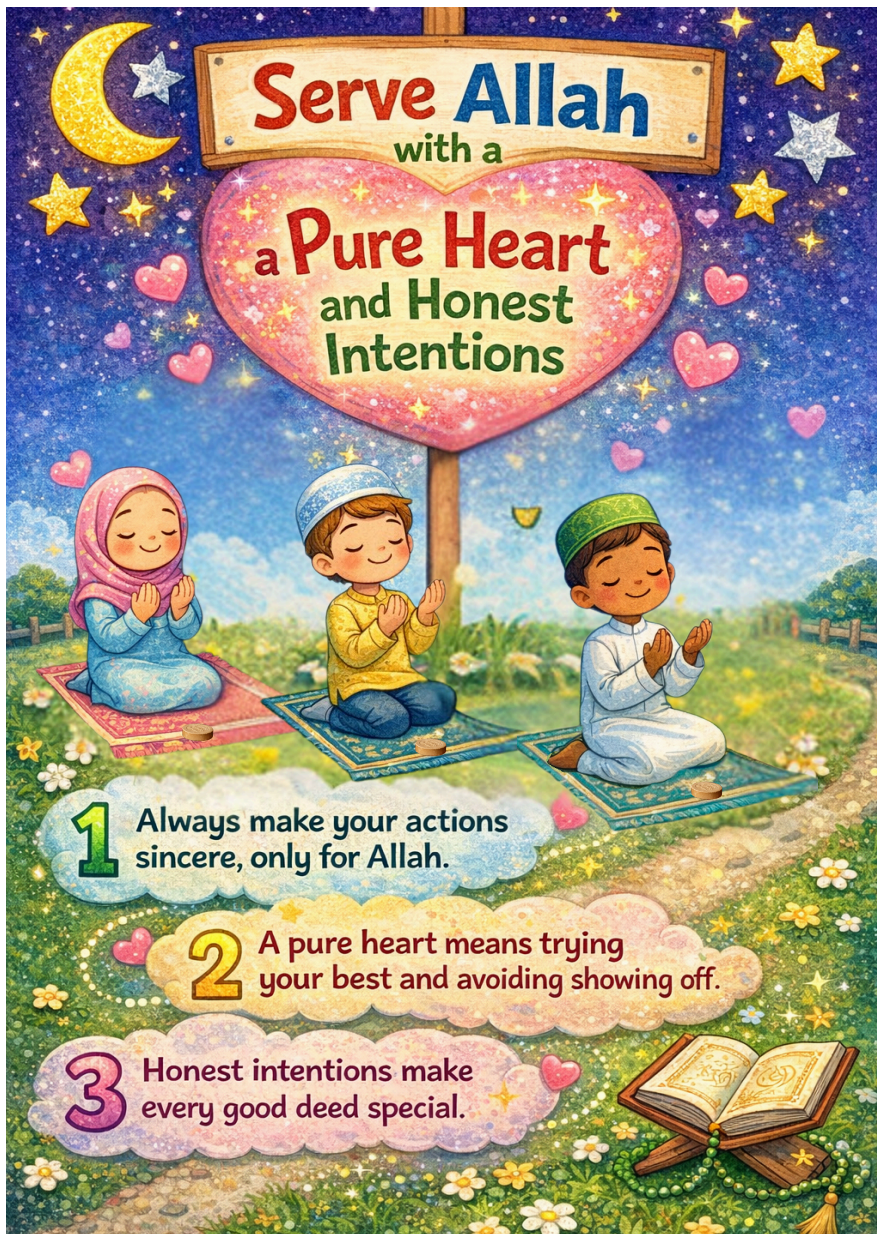

# Pure Hearts

When I feel hungry or thirsty while I'm fasting, it reminds me that one day we will all stand before Allah. Feeling a little hungry now helps me understand that the Day of Judgment will be serious, and everyone will need Allah's mercy and forgiveness.

# Whole-Body Fasting

الِاسْتِمَاعُ إِلَيْهِ أَسْمَاعَكُمْ، وَتَحَنَّنُوا عَلَى أَيْتَامِ النَّاسِ يُتَحَنَّنَ عَلَى أَيْتَامِكُمْ

“Guard your tongues, look away from that which is not permissible for your sight, close your ears to that which is forbidden to hear, show compassion to the orphans of other people so compassion may be shown to your orphans.”



My Noble Prophet (p) ❤️ teaches me that Ramadan is a time to make my heart soft, my words sweet, and my actions kind. When **I am careful with what I say, see, hear, and show love to others**, Allah is happy with me!

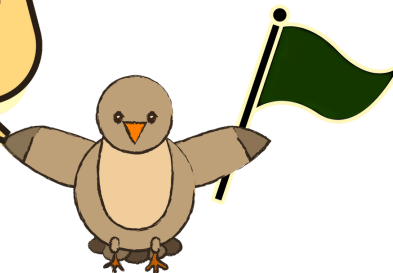

My Noble Prophet (p) ❤️ teaches me that when I raise my hands and talk to Allah, He listens, and **prayer time is The BEST time to make dua.**

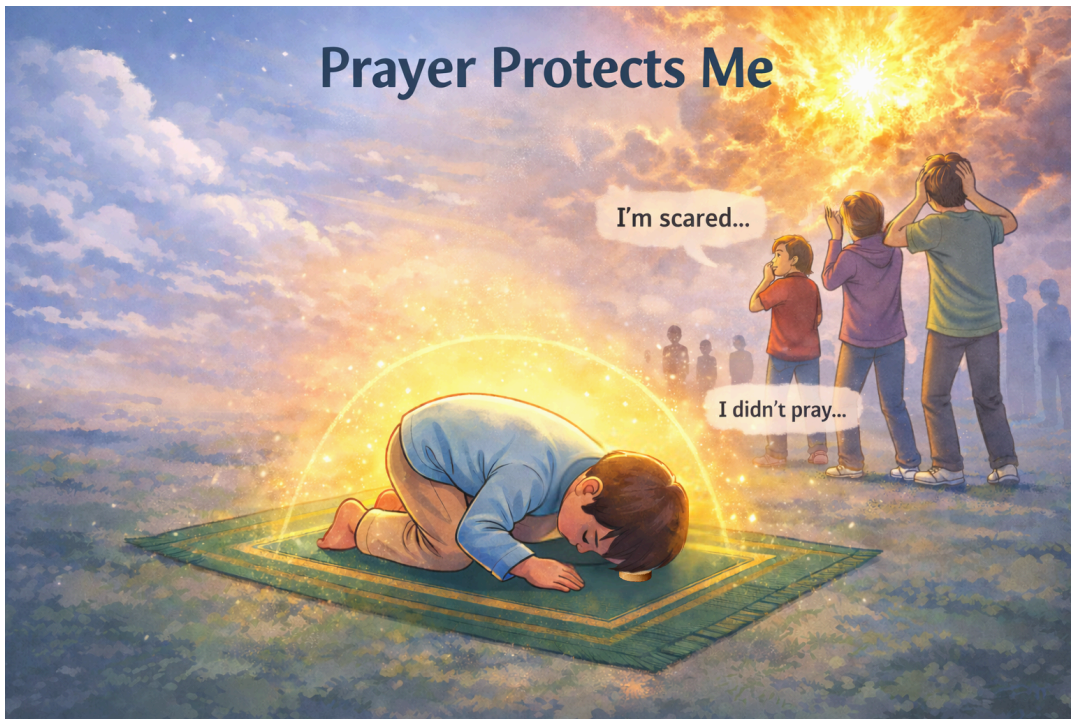

# Salah Protects Me

يَوْمَ يَقُومُ النَّاسُ لِرَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ

“Know that Allah swears by His Might that He does not punish those who pray and prostrate, and He will not frighten them with the fire of the day when people stand before the Lord of the worlds”



When I pray and make Sujūd, Allah protects me and I don't need to be afraid.

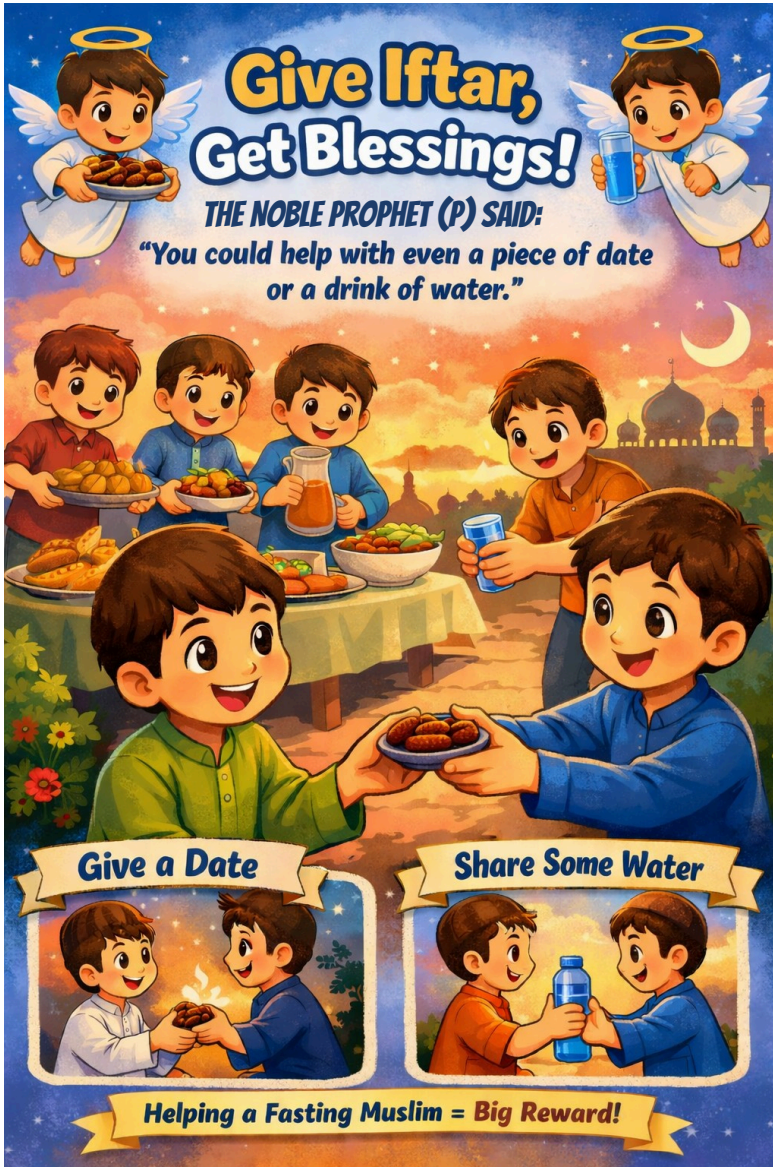
When I want Allah's protection, I should:

# Giving Iftar

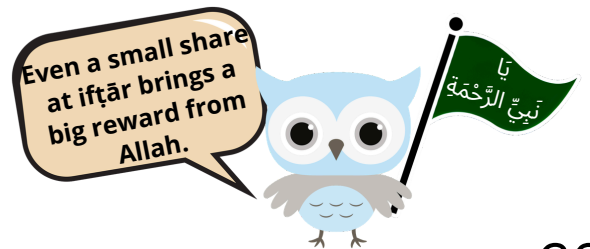
قَنْ فَطَّرَ مِنْكُمْ صَائِمًا فُؤِينَا فِي هَذَا الشَّهْرِ كَانَ لَهُ بِذَلِكَ عِنْدَ اللَّهِ عِتْقُ نَسَمَةٍ وَمَغْفِرَةٌ لِمَا قَضَى مِنْ ذُنُوبِهِ. قِيلَ: يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ، وَلَيْسَ كُلُّنَا يَقْدِرُ عَلَى ذَلِكَ! فَقَالَ: «إِتَّقُوا النَّارَ وَلَوْ بِشِقِّ تَمْرَةٍ، إِتَّقُوا النَّارَ وَلَوْ بِشَرْبَةِ مِائَةٍ».

“One who gives food to a believer to break his fast is given the reward of freeing a slave and his past sins will be forgiven. Some people said: O Prophet of Allah, not all of us are able to invite those who are fasting. The Prophet said: You could avoid hellfire with even a piece of date or a drink of water”

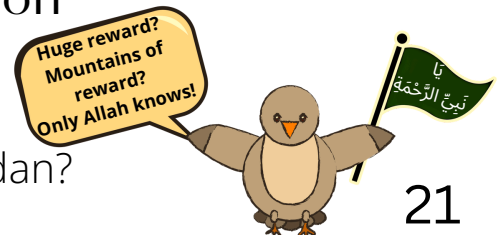
“The one who recites one verse from the holy Quran in this month will be given the reward of reciting the whole Quran during other months”

# The Great Verse

In blessed month of Ramadan, my family and I try to read the whole Qur'an because we are special guests of Allah and He showers us with so many blessings. But here's a question: what is "The BEST" verse in the Quran that I can recite after every prayer, all year long? Who can answer this question?



Of course, the one who taught me about "The Best" month: My Noble Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessing be upon him and his pure family) ❤️

In a narration My Noble Prophet (p) said:

عَنْ النَّبِيِّ (ص): إِنَّ أَعْظَمَ آيَةٍ فِي الْقُرْآنِ آيَةُ الْكُرْسِيِّ.

**"Indeed, Ayat al-Kursi is the greatest verse in the Qur'an"**

Do you know where *Āyat al-Kursī* is in the Qur'an?

It is in Surah Al-Baqarah, verse 255!



The Noble Prophet (p) said, addressing Amir al-Mu'minin (p):

«يَا عَلِيُّ... وَالْقُرْآنُ سَيِّدُ الْكَلَامِ، وَسُورَةُ الْبَقَرَةِ سَيِّدَةُ الْقُرْآنِ، وَآيَةُ الْكُرْسِيِّ

سَيِّدَةُ سُورَةِ الْبَقَرَةِ. فِيهَا خَمْسُونَ كَلِمَةً، فِي كُلِّ كَلِمَةٍ بَرَكَةٌ.»

"O Ali, the Qur'an is the master of all speech, and Surah al-Baqarah is the master of the Qur'an, and **Ayat al-Kursi is the master of Surah al-Baqarah**. It contains fifty words, and in every word there is a blessing."
